ASHLEY WILLIAMS

This **eclectic British designer** is poised to take the world by storm.

ho'd have thought the next It bag would be a cuddly elephant with a strap? Or that kooky skater-motif trousers would become a fall must-have? That's the power of newcomer Ashley Williams. "I first started noticing clothing as a kid in the '90s," the 27-year-old explains. "My brother was into Alien Workshop and No Fear, so a lot of my graphics and colors are nostalgic." But beneath the cutesy kitsch of the stuffed-toy creations (which were based on an old novelty pajama case belonging to Ashley's mother), fluffy coats, and cartoon-print dresses is London's hardest-working young designer, whose name is now uttered, by those in the know, in the same breath as Erdem and Christopher Kane.

In addition to a lot of hard work. Ashley gets by with a little help from her friends. Gal pal Alex Brownsell, of famed dye company Bleach London, does the hair for her shows; Georgia May Jagger has walked the runway; and former flatmate Pixie Geldof wears her pieces to lead the front-row posse-among them Alexa Chung, Daisy Lowe, and Scout Willis. Not surprisingly, Ashley's buddies act as muses when she's thinking about upcoming collections. "What I really like is how they take the clothes and wear them in their own way. depending on their personal look," Ashley says. Other inspirations are found in a familiar click-and-scroll: "I'm an Instagram screen-grabber, for sure-I love good street-style pictures." -GRACE TIMOTHY
